SQ3R

- Survey – skim the selection, making note of headings, illustrations, boldfaced type
- Question – question what you hope to learn from the selection
- Read – read carefully, taking notes, reread if necessary
- Recite – recite aloud the *who, what, when, where, why, and how* of the selection
- Review – summarize in writing what you have read
